

8 weeks to Christmas shutdown

Most quarries and mines have a break over Christmas. The concern is that some may not be re-opening in January 2017 - at least not with the required CoC holder in place.

This Train Brain is entirely focused on training available to those who still have not completed their CoCs. WorkSafe has signalled it needs to know by mid-November who needs to be assessed about their renewal of competencies. It needs the following few weeks to get those assessments completed.

Please look at the training options detailed below, including oral exam prep. Some providers are willing to run courses if there are as few as half a dozen people ready to do the training.

Let's see a concerted effort in the new few weeks to get the brain into training.

Preparation courses for COC oral exams

Amid increasing concern about some poor oral exam results as the end of year CoC deadline approaches, Mines Rescue has stepped up its programme of courses designed to prepare people, particularly for B grade extractive exams.

It says many applicants have never been in front of a board or panel before and they need to develop confidence in such situations and learn to structure their answers so the Panel is confident of their competence. and concludes with simulated exams and individual feedback on performance.
